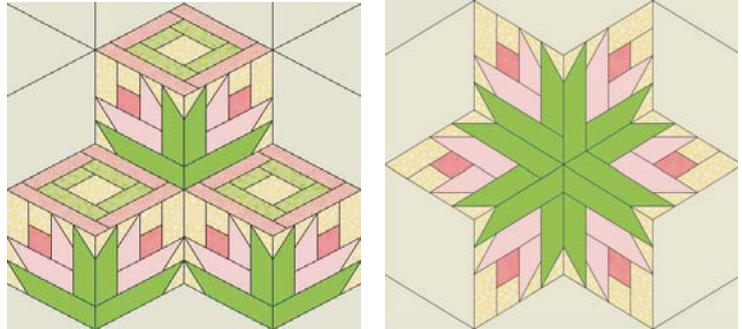
Design a Baby Block or Hexagon Star Quilt and *draw FPP Prints*

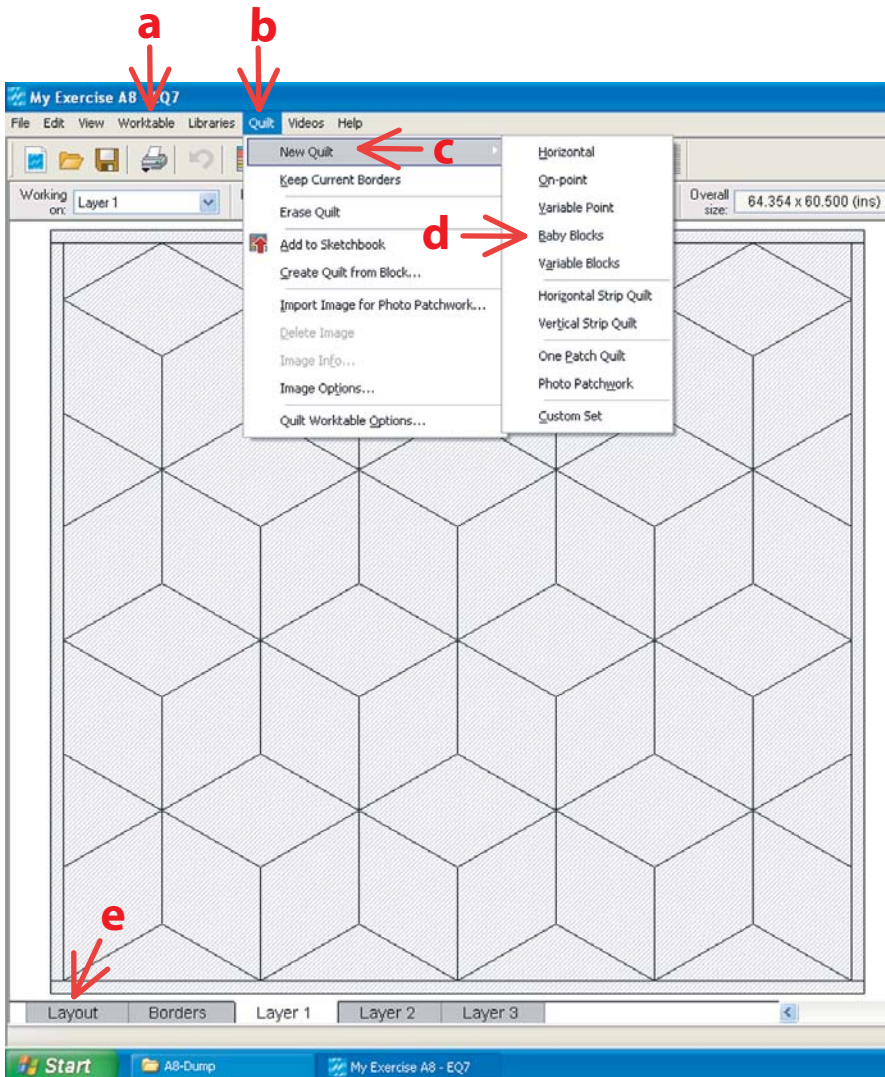

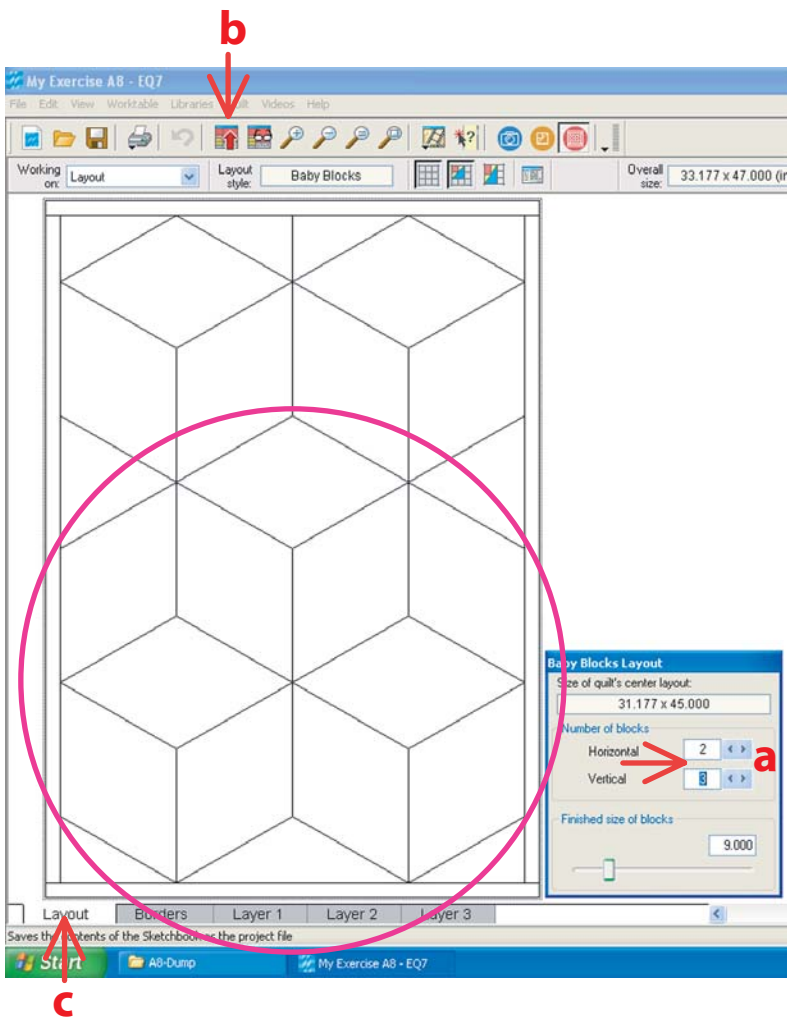
click **a Worktable**

click **e Layout**



2.1 Change Block Layout for Small Quilts

change **a** *Horizontal to 2,*
Vertical to 3
for a **3 Block Quilt**
or **one Hexagonal Star**

click **b** *Add to Sketchbook*

click **c** *Layout*

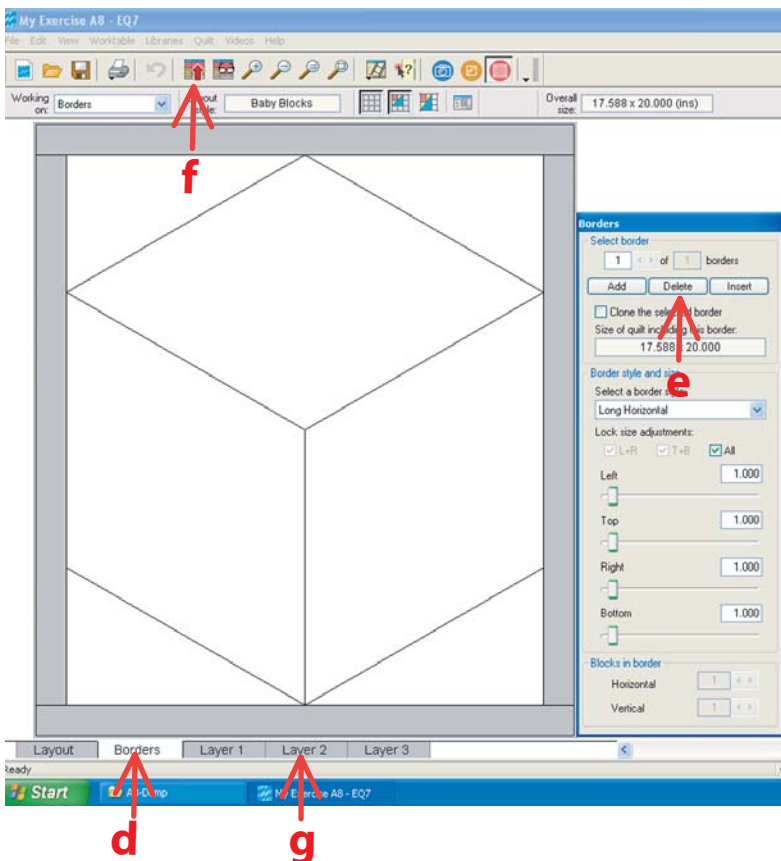
change **a** *Horizontal to 1,*
Vertical to 1
for a **Single Baby Block**

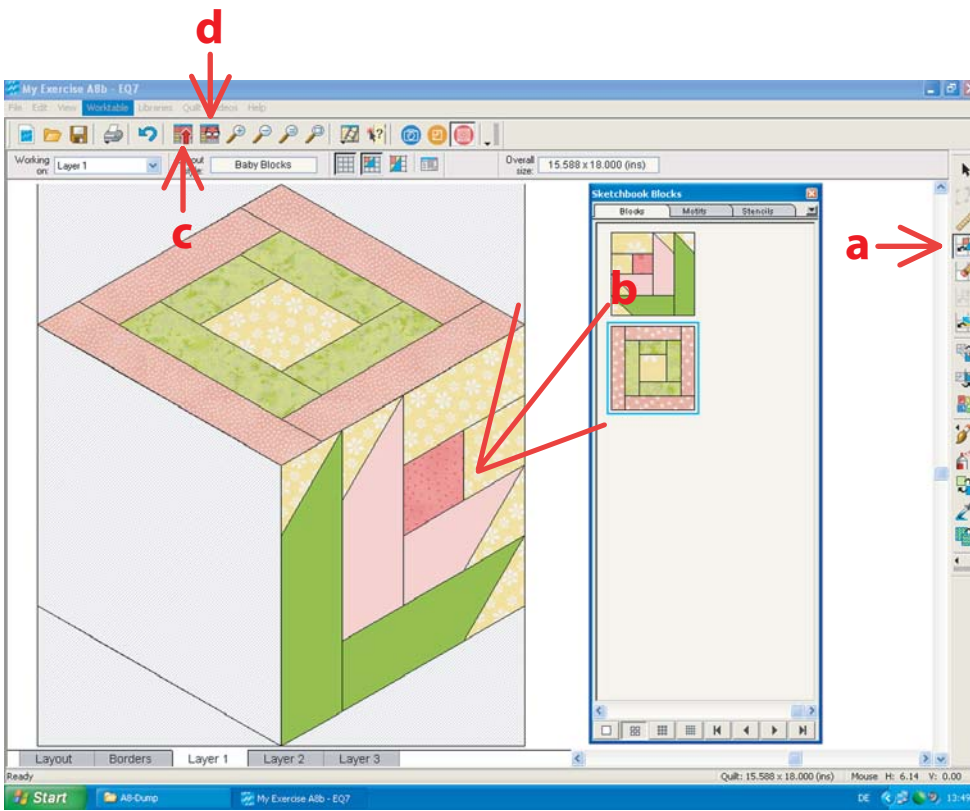
click **d** *Borders*

click **e** *Delete*

click **f** *Add to Sketchbook*

click **g** *Layout 1*





2.3 Setting Blocks into a Quilt Layout

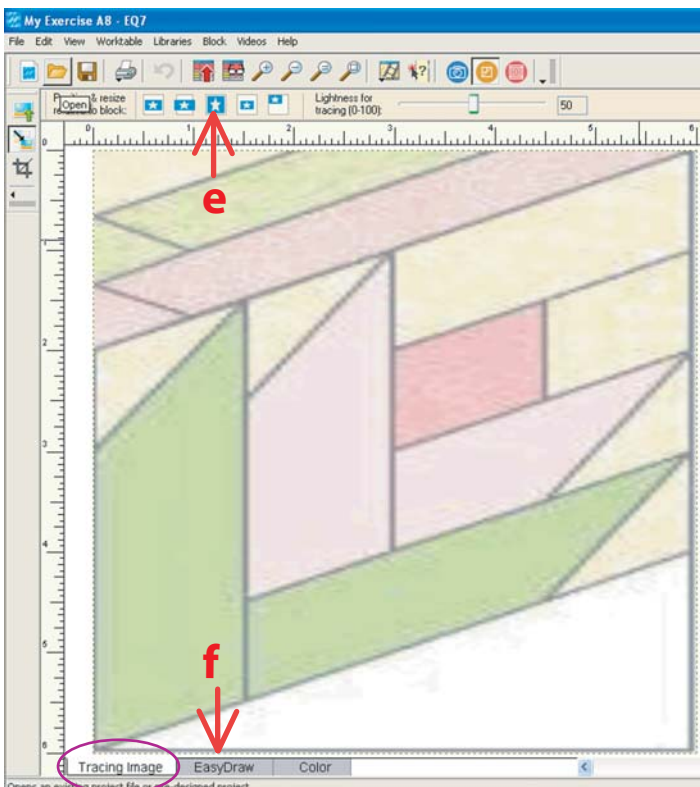

click **a Set Block**
 click , hold and drag **b**
 click **c Add to Sketchbook**

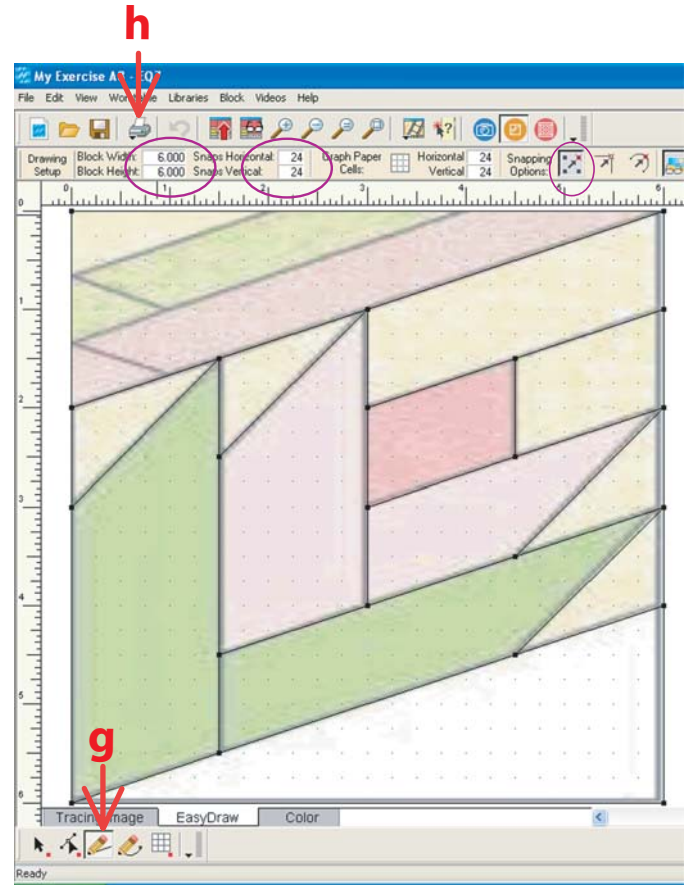

click **d View Sketchbook- PHOTOS - Edit...>> to Block Worktable**

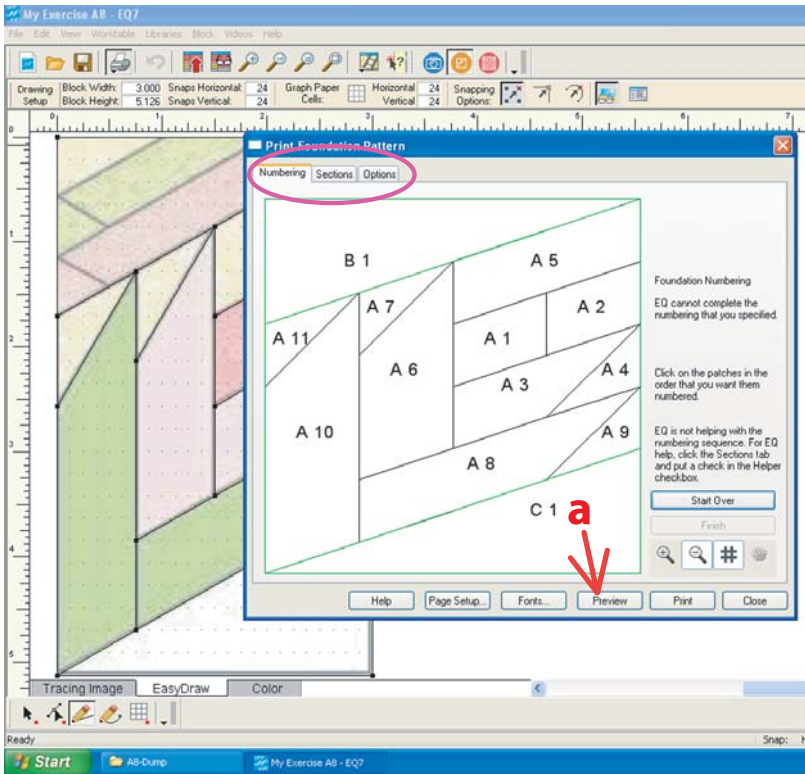


click **e Distort Fit**
 click **f EasyDraw**



keep **Block Dimensions 6 x 6 inches, Snaps 24 and Snapping Option.**

click **g Draw Lines**
 click **h Print - Foundation Piecing**



2.4 Printing a Foundation Piecing Pattern

click **Options**, **Width** 3.0 x 5.126 in.
(Dimensions generated by cropping the Block Drawing)

click **Option, Sections**,
check **Section and number myself**
without the help of EQ7

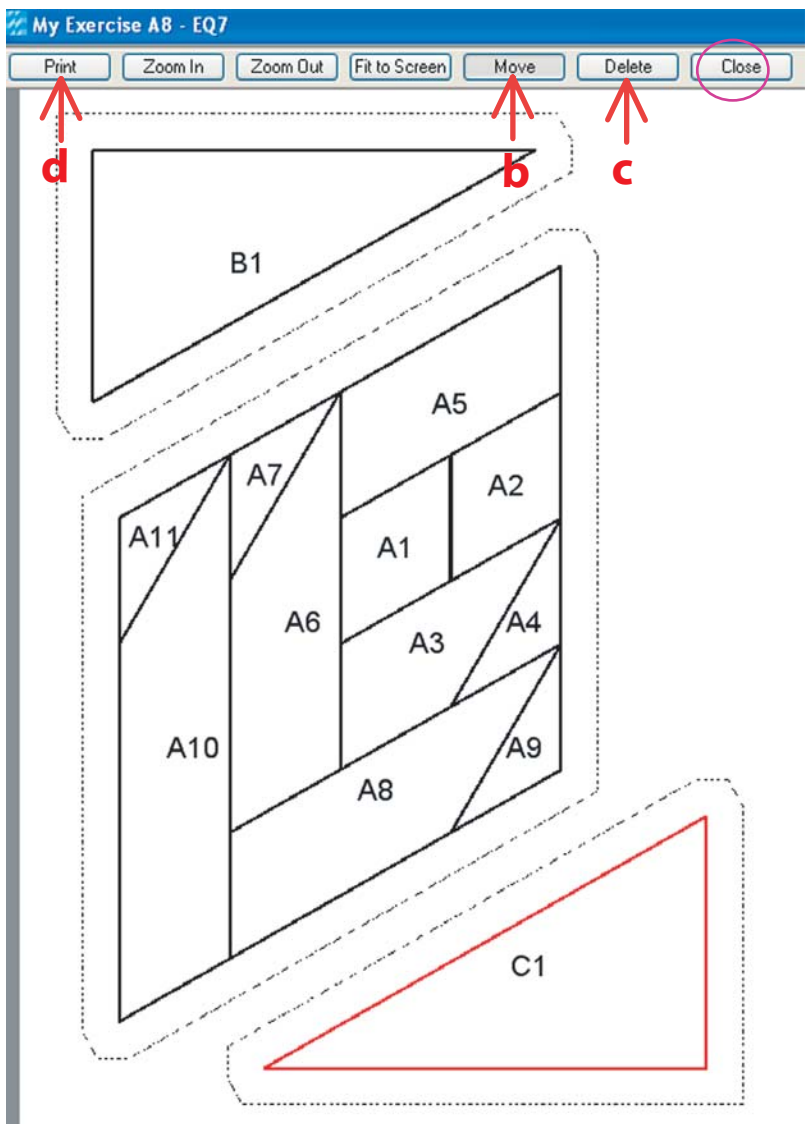
Start over **A1 to A11, Group**

B1, Group

C1 Group

check **Numbering**

click **a** **Preview**

click **c** **Delete Sections**

click **d** **Print**
