load it to your **Sketchbook**

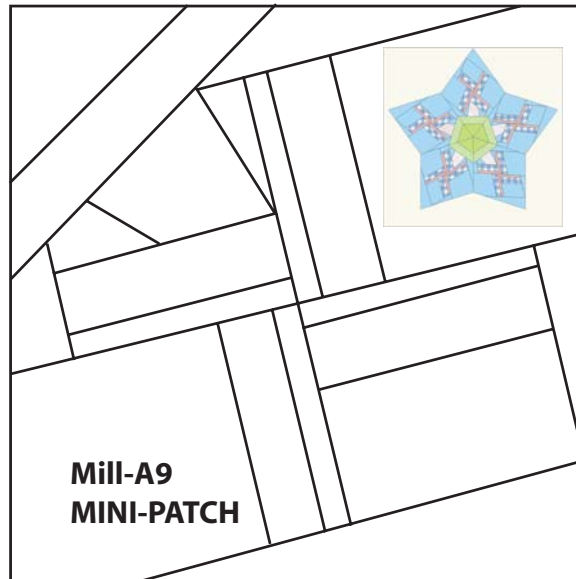
- draw an **EasyDraw** Block

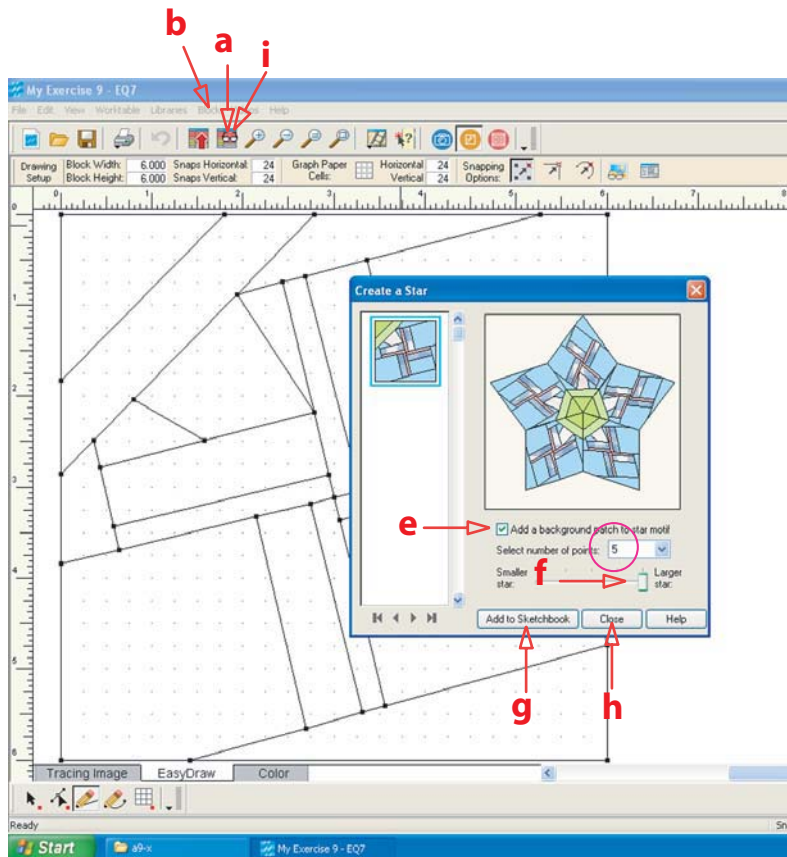
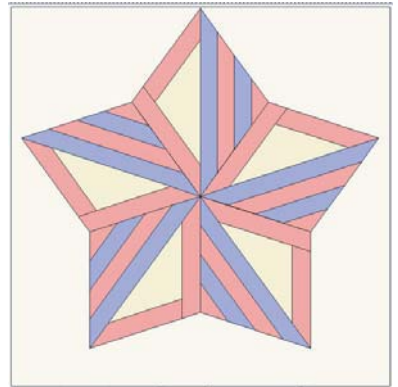

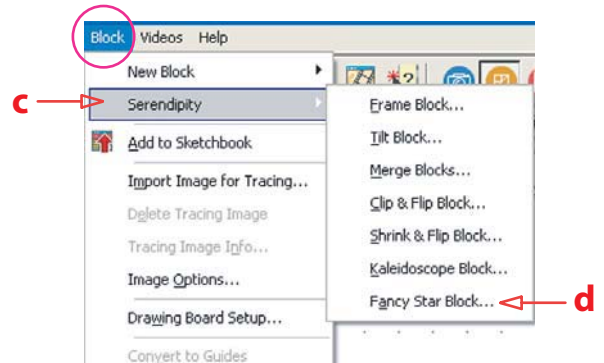

2. Make a Fancy Star Block

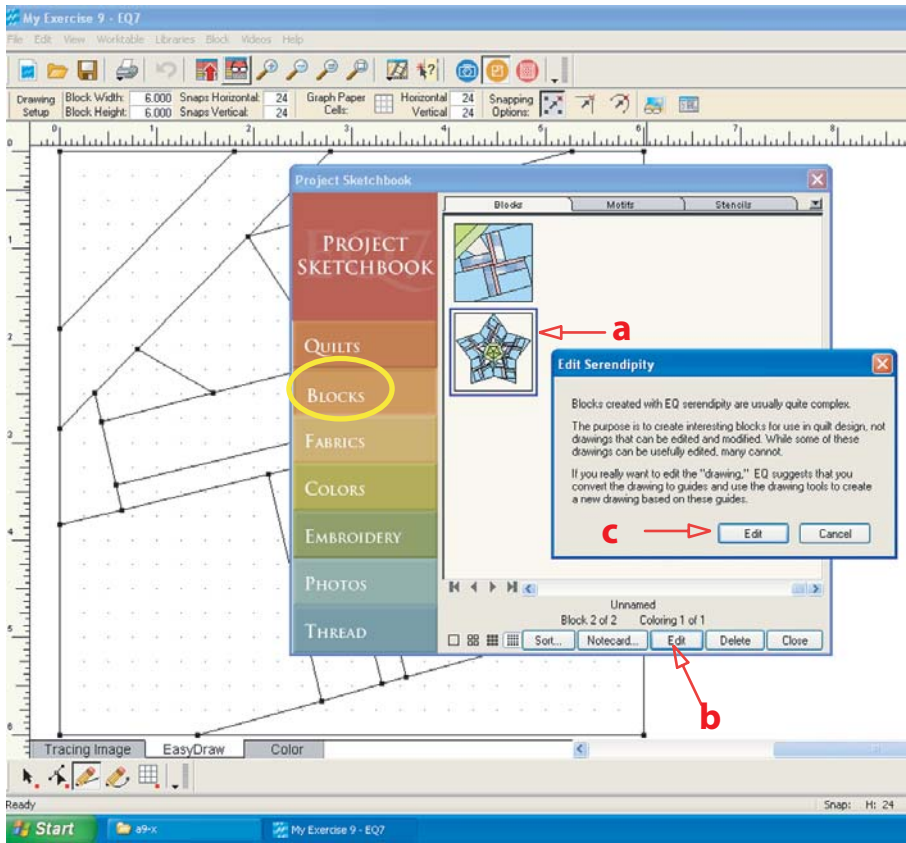

- click **Edit** on the **Project Sketchbook Blocks**
- (Mill A9 or Basket or your Selection)
- click **b Block** on the Menu
- click **c Serendipity**
- click **d Fancy Star Block**
- click **e Add a Background IMPORTANT**
- click **f Slide to Larger**
- click **g Add to Sketchbook**
- click **h Close**
- click **i** open **View Sketchbook**

click **b** *Edit* on the Project Sketchbook

click **c** *Edit* on Edit Serendipity

click **d** *Worktable*

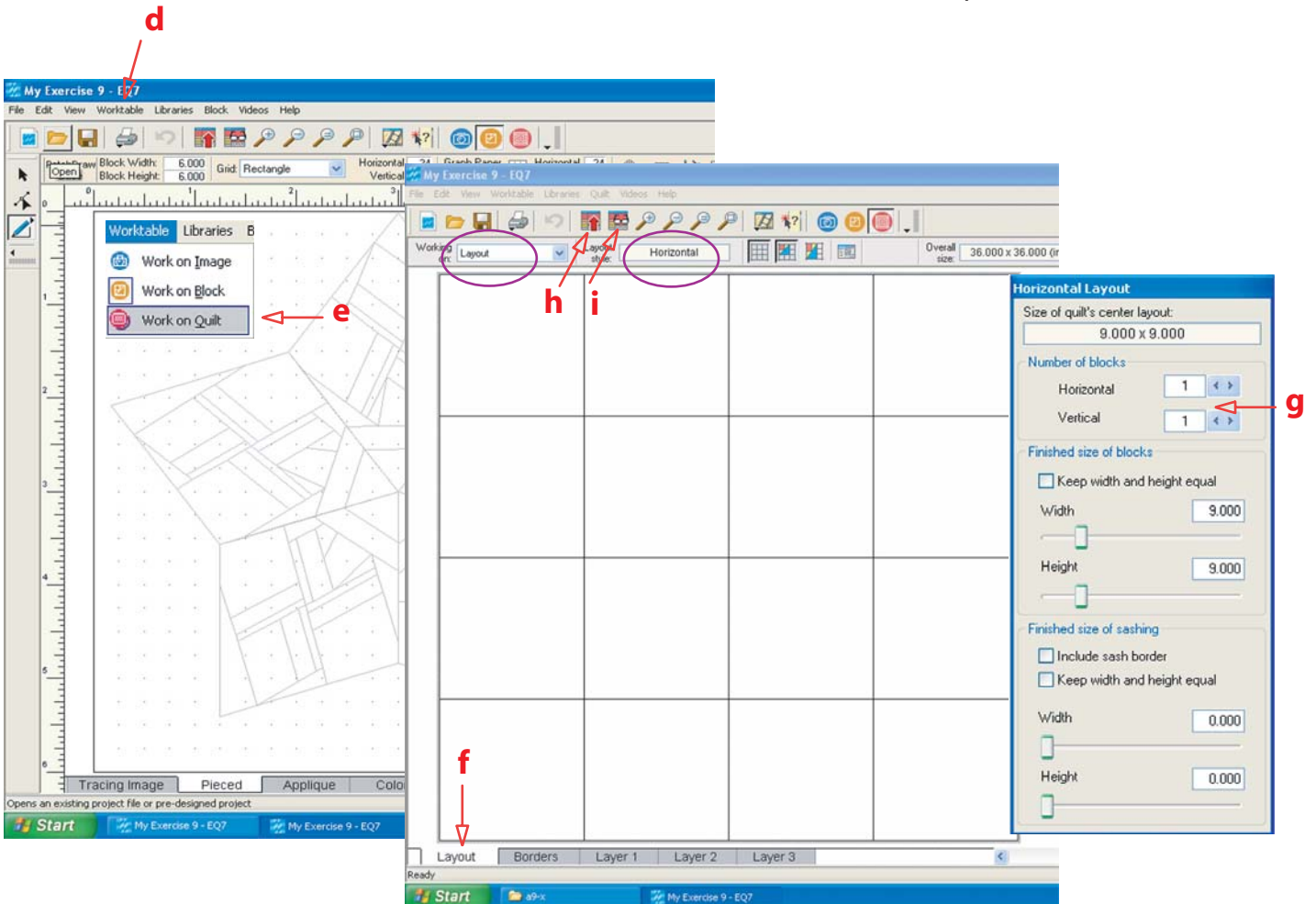
click **e** *Work on Quilt* on Worktable

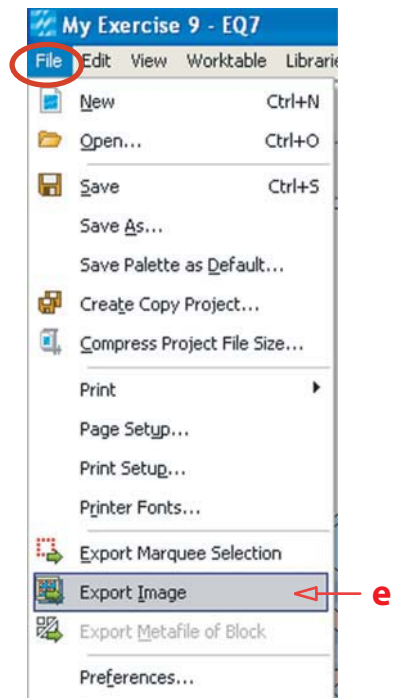
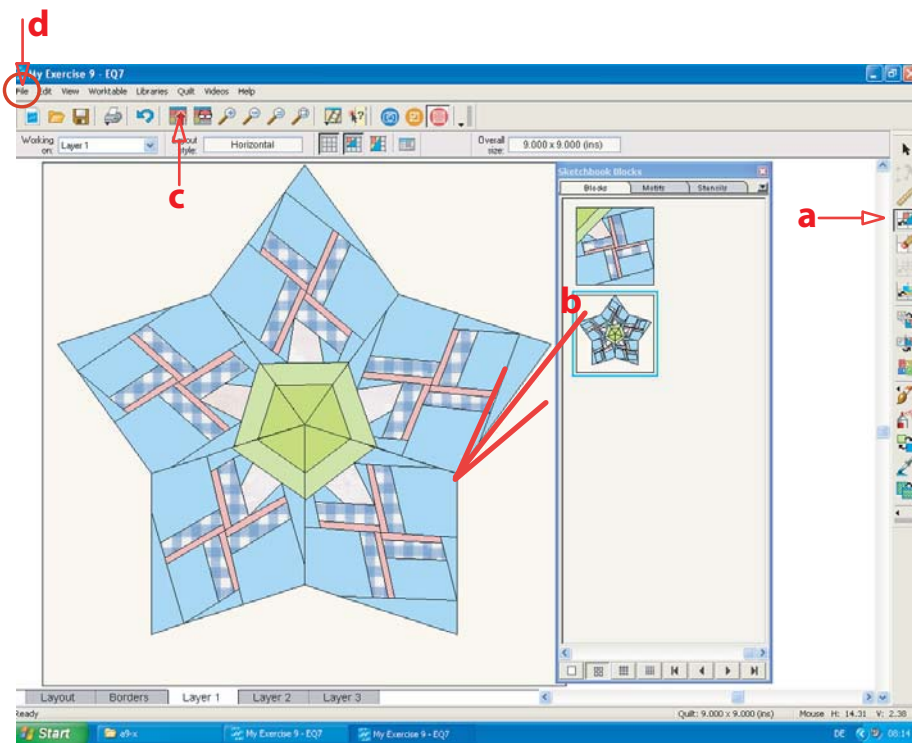
click **f** *Layout* on Quilt Layout,

set **g** *Number of bloks* to 1

click **h** *Add to Sketchbook*

click **i** open *Sketchbook-Quilts*

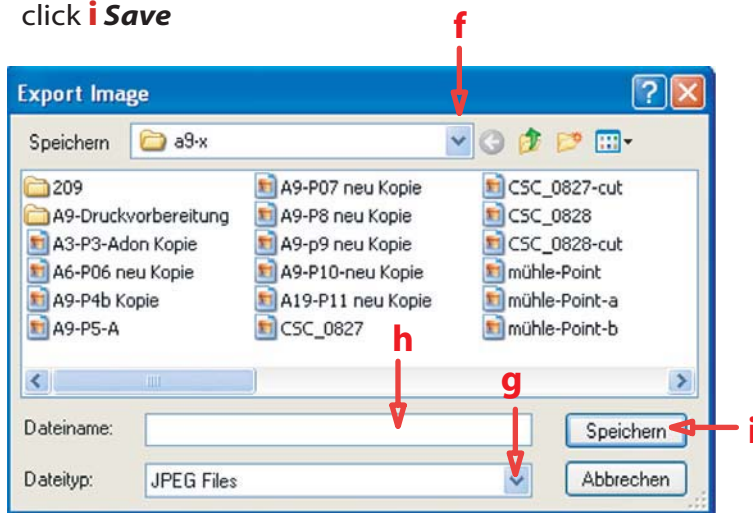
click **a** *Set Block*
 click **b** hold, drag and release
 click **c** *Add to Sketchbook*

click **d** *File*
 click **e** *Export Image*

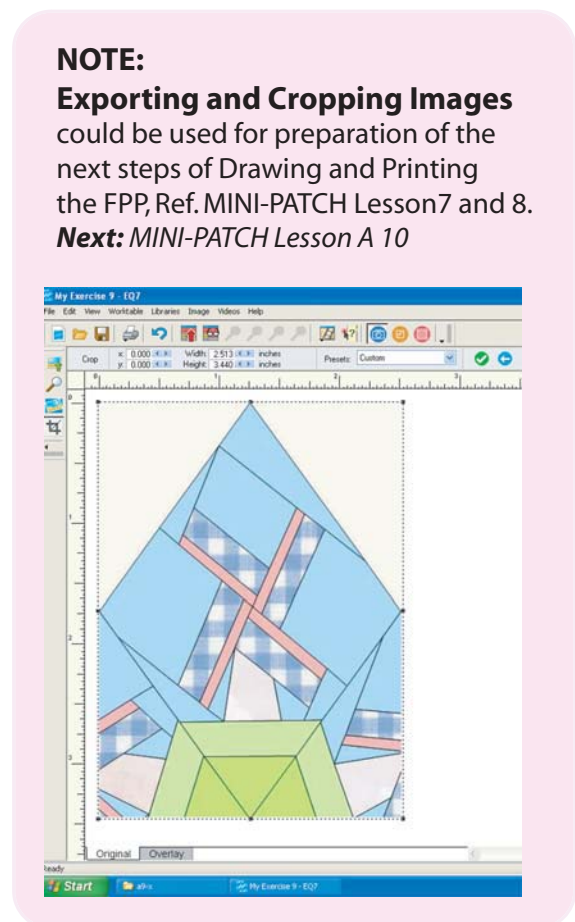
click **f** *Save in*
 click **g** choose file type (JPEG, TIFF, GIF or PNG)
 click **h** type a name of your image
 click **i** *Save*



2.4 Drawing an EasyDraw Block

- Load the image to your Graphic Program (Paint or else)
- crop one point and save
- Starting the Block and import image for tracing
- Print the Foundation Piecing Pattern
